Over \$1.2 million In Capital Improvements

In the fall of 2008, we will complete our new Medical Office Building. We have also added a multi-slice CT Scanner and made a number of quality improvements to our state-of-the-art facility including expanding our behavioral health unit to include eight geriatric beds.

Contributing To Our Local Tax Base

Last year, Bourbon Community Hospital paid \$116,842 in local property taxes, and \$28,592 in state sales taxes.

Helping Those In Need

Bourbon Community Hospital has provided over \$2,730,000 in uncompensated care for those lacking sufficient financial resources, along with \$1,853,000 in Indigent Provider taxes to fund State Medicaid. This continues to be an important mission of the hospital.

Adding New Physicians

During the past 12 months, Bourbon Community Hospital has added thirteen new physicians to our highly respected medical staff, including specialists in Cardiology, Dentistry, Emergency Medicine, Family Practice, Internal Medicine/Hospitalist, Nephrology, Obstetrics/Gynecology, Ophthalmology, Pathology, Podiatry, Psychiatry, and Radiology.
