Over \$4.3 million in capital improvements

In 2008, we invested over \$4.3 million in our facility which included technology replacement, information technology additions/updates, and routine facility upkeep and maintenance.

In 2009, we will complete Hopewell Medical Complex which houses our Sleep Lab, Specialty Clinic and will provide space for newly recruited physicians and specialists. We also expanded our behavioral health unit to include eight geriatric beds.

Contributing to our local tax base

Last year, Bourbon Community Hospital paid over \$565,000 in taxes that have helped to support our city, county and state. This included sales taxes as well as property taxes. These dollars help to support local schools, development of roads, recruitment of business and industry, and other needed services.

Helping those in need

Bourbon Community Hospital provided over \$19.6 million in uncompensated care last year, which included the amounts not covered by government-sponsored programs such as Medicare and Medicaid. This amount includes \$2.6 million for charity care and bad debts, incurred as we cared for many people without sufficient resources.

Adding new physicians

During the past year, Bourbon Community Hospital added several new physicians to our highly respected medical staff, including specialists in hospital medicine (hospitalists) and nephrology.

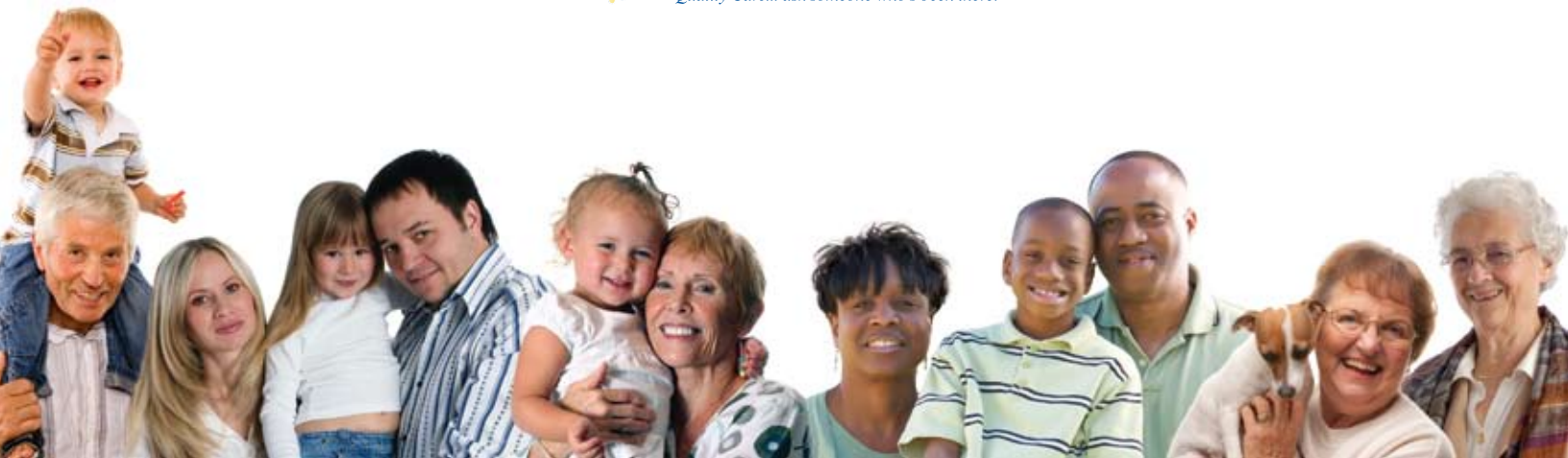
One of our community's major employers

In addition, the hospital provides free health screenings and information at its annual Community Health Fair and Senior Friends Day. The hospital also sponsors a Business Health Breakfast/Seminar quarterly for local business leaders. "Government-sponsored health care" includes governmental and private payor contractual adjustments or reductions. "Capital investments" include facility expansions/renovations, equipment purchases, technology replacement, information technology additions/updates, and routine facility upkeep and maintenance.
