Over \$950,000 In Improvements

In 2007, we completed several major projects. To our physical plant, we upgraded both of the elevators and installed new air handlers to improve our HVAC system. We have also added a new monitoring program for the Birthing Center; brand new monitors in each of the ICU patient rooms and nurses station, and made a number of quality improvements to our state-of-the-art facility including the addition of security systems for our Emergency Room, ICU, and OB Units, digitized our Radiology department and added a brand new service with our Sleep Lab.

Contributing To Our Local Tax Base

Last year, Andalusia Regional paid \$147,581 in local property taxes, and \$239,058 in local sales taxes.

Helping Those In Need

Andalusia Regional has provided over \$5.1 million in uncompensated care for those lacking sufficient financial resources. This continues to be an important mission of the hospital.

Adding New Physicians

During the past eighteen months, Andalusia Regional has added 5 new physicians to our highly respected medical staff, including specialists in obstetrics, gynecology, neurology, and internal medicine.
