Over \$2,000,000 In Capital Improvements

In the next 6 months, we will complete extensive renovations to our main medical office building and begin additional renovations in Radiology and our Emergency Department. We have also added an advance endoscopy reporting system and made a number of quality improvements to our facility including the construction of a new \$1.7 million dollar medical office building.

Contributing To Our Local Tax Base

Last year, Bluegrass Community Hospital paid \$102,411 in local B&O taxes to support local infrastructure, \$55,382 in local property taxes, and \$106,276 in local sales taxes.

Helping Those In Need

Bluegrass Community Hospital has provided over \$ 2.4 million in uncompensated care for those lacking sufficient financial resources, along with \$261,412 in Indigent Provider taxes to fund Kentucky Medicaid. This continues to be an important mission of the hospital.

Adding New Physicians

During the past 2 years, Bluegrass Community Hospital has added 6 new physicians to our highly respected medical staff, including specialists in Anesthesia, Emergency, Family Practice, Gastroenterology, General Surgery, and Hospital Medicine.
