### Over \$4,955,433 In Capital Improvements

In 2007, we began work on the complete renovation of our Medical/Surgical Department, located on the sixth floor of the hospital. We also added a top of the line 64-Slice CT scanner and made a number of quality improvements to our state-of-the-art facility.

### Contributing To Our Local Tax Base

Last year, Teche Regional Medical Center paid \$82,183 in local property taxes, and \$179,972 in local sales taxes.

### Helping Those In Need

Teche Regional has provided over \$21,419,627 in uncompensated care for those lacking sufficient financial resources, along with \$64,641,479 in Indigent Provider taxes to fund State Medicaid. This continues to be an important mission of the hospital.

During the past two years, Teche Regional has added three new physicians to our highly respected medical staff, including specialists in Anesthesia, Family Medicine, and Surgery.
