Investing in our facility

In 2008, we began construction on a \$5.6 million Emergency Room expansion project due to be completed in June 2009. We have also added an echocardiogram unit in our Radiology Department and computer-assisted joint replacement in our Surgical Services Department. In early 2009, we will add Digital Mammography.

Contributing to our local tax base

Last year, Crockett Hospital paid more than \$1.1 million in taxes that have helped to support our city, county and state. This included sales taxes as well as property taxes. These dollars help to support local schools, development of roads, recruitment of business and industry, and other needed services.

Helping those In need

Crockett Hospital has provided more than \$44 million in uncompensated care, which includes the amounts not covered by Medicare and Medicaid. Additionally, providing for many people without sufficient resources, we provided more than \$3.5 million in charity care and bad debt.

Adding new physicians

During the past year, Crockett Hospital has added five new physicians to our highly respected medical staff, including specialists in Dermatology, Family Practice, Neurology, Orthopaedics and Otolaryngology. A Board-Certified Psychiatrist is scheduled to arrive in June 2009.
