Millions invested in capital improvements

In 2009, we completed a \$7.6 million expansion project that included major renovations to our Emergency Department and our Radiology Departments. We've also recently added a new magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) scanner. And, we're in the process of completing renovations to our Cardiac Catheterization Laboratories after adding new interventional cardiac services last year.

Contributing to our local tax base

Last year, Meadowview Regional Medical Center paid more than \$1.1 million in taxes that have helped to support our

city, county and state. This included sales taxes as well as property taxes. These dollars help to support local schools, development of roads, recruitment of business and industry, and other needed services.

Helping those in need

Meadowview Regional Medical Center provided over \$41.2 million in uncompensated care last year, which included the amounts not covered by government-sponsored programs such as Medicare and Medicaid. This amount includes \$6.1 million for charity care and bad debts, incurred as we cared for many people without sufficient resources.

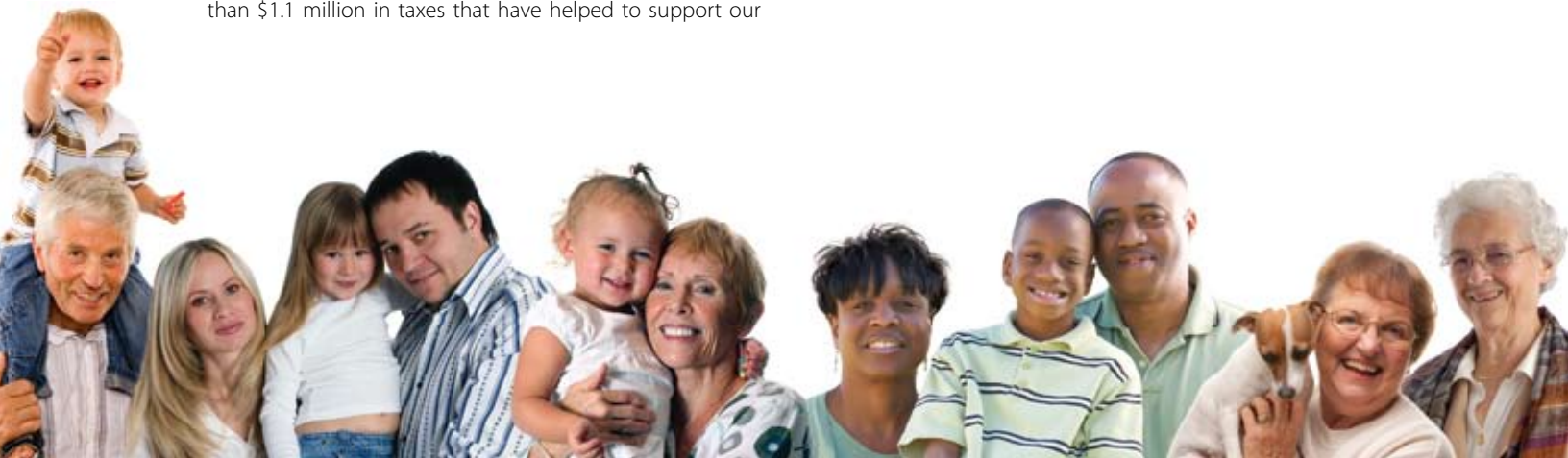
Adding New Physicians

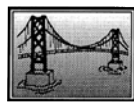
During the past year, Meadowview Regional Medical Center added several new physicians to our highly respected medical staff, including specialists in family practice, general surgery, pediatrics and urology.

"Capital investments" include facility expansions/renovations, equipment purchases, technology replacement, information technology additions/updates, and routine facility upkeep and maintenance.
